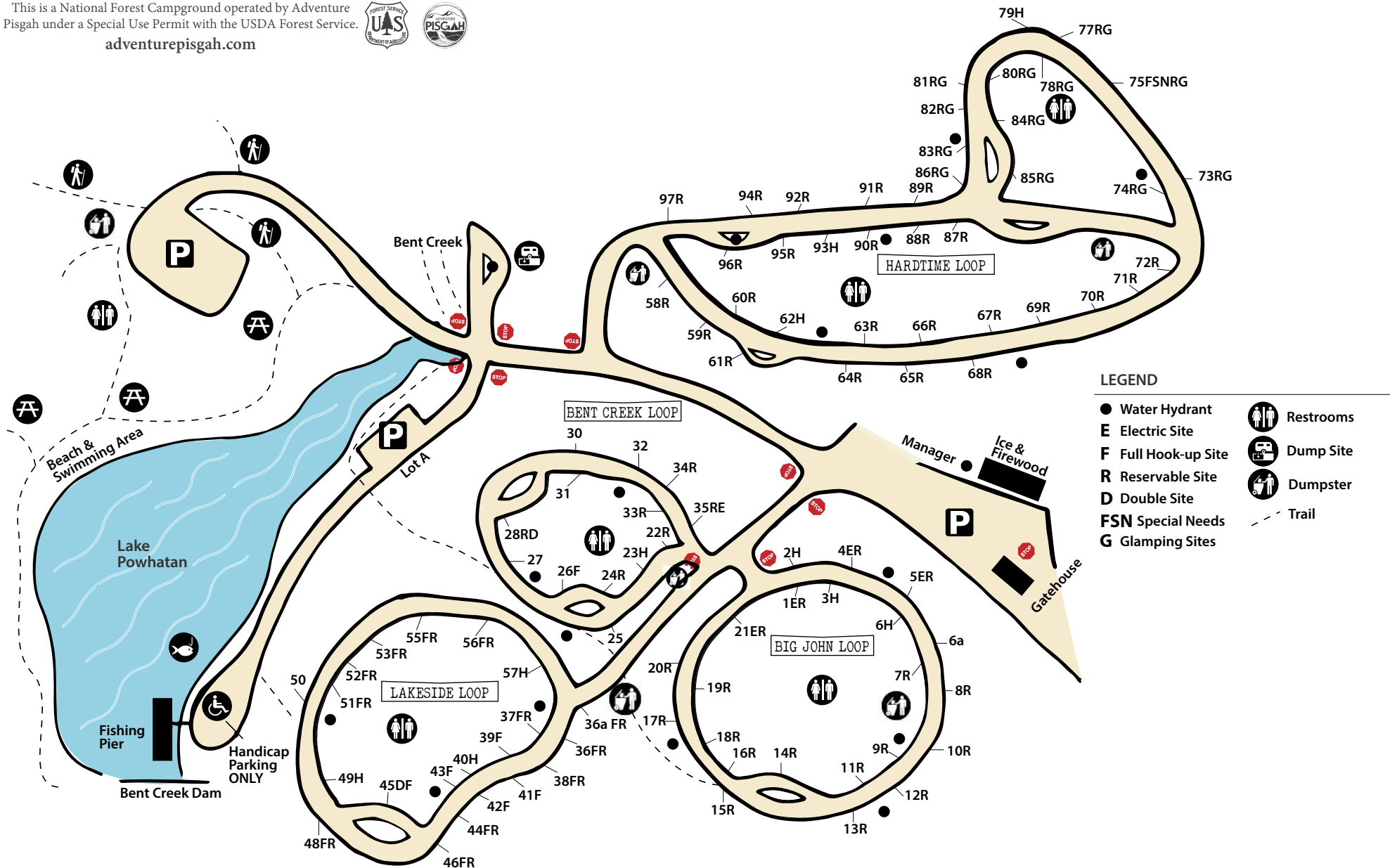


Lake Powhatan Campground & Recreation Area Map

Hours:

- **Gatehouse:** 8am - 8pm, March 27th to November 15th
- **Lake Beach:** 10am-8pm
- **Check-out time** is 12pm.
- The campground gate closes at 10pm.
- **Quiet hours:** 10pm to 7am

Beach: Flotation devices are not permitted in the lake, with the exception of US Coast Guard-approved PFDs. Pets are not permitted in the beach area.

Rentals: Site rentals are only available to individuals who are at least 18 years old. All activities at the campsite are the responsibility of the renter, and sites must be occupied on the first night of the visit.

Reservations are available through the National Recreation Reservation Service at 1-877-444-6777 or recreation.gov.

Federal Interagency Passes (Senior and Access) are only permitted for single campsites. The person who uses the pass and occupies the campsite must be the same person to whom the pass was issued.

Refunds: All site refund requests are processed through recreation.gov. Refunds are not granted for weather-related circumstances; they are only considered for emergency situations.

Stay Limits: The cumulative 14 days (within a 30-day time period) applies to all Forest Service areas within 10 miles of the previously occupied campsite. Included in a cumulative stay limit: Davidson River, Lake Powhatan, North Mills River and Sunburst.

Campsite Capacity:

- Single campsites: up to 8 people, 2 vehicles and 1 wheeled camper
- Double campsites: up to 16 people, 4 vehicles and 2 wheeled campers
- Fees will be added for additional vehicles
- Any vehicle that does not fit on the pavement at the campsite must be relocated to the overflow parking area and will be subject to the extra vehicle fee.

Visitors: Hang tags are required and obtained upon entering the campground. Visitors must exit the campground by 9pm.

Parking: Vehicles must be backed into campsites and only parked on the asphalt. Please secure wheels on parking spurs or tent pads.

Speed Limit: Visitors must adhere to traffic signs and the 15-MPH speed limit in accordance with NC State Law.

Pets: Keep all pets leashed or caged during your visit to the campground. Dog fences are not permitted. Pets are not allowed in bathrooms. Clean up after your pet throughout your stay.

Weapons and Fireworks: Individuals in possession of firearms must conform to NC State Law. Weapons and fireworks cannot be discharged inside the campground or within 150 yards of the campground under any circumstance.

Lost and Found: Contact the campground manager for lost items that may be in the Lost and Found. Unclaimed items will be donated to a local charity.

Bathrooms are located throughout the campground for campers use. Portable bathrooms are strictly prohibited.

Water Tanks: Potable water station is available and labeled at the dump station.

Tents: Campers need to place tents within the gravel area of their campsite.

Hammocks: Hammocks may only be used at designated sites. Please see staff for further information.

Firewood: Firewood is available for purchase at the gatehouse.

Campfires: Campfires are allowed in fire rings only; no other location is permissible for a campfire. "Dead and Down" wood is acceptable firewood, but do not remove trees, branches or any vegetation, whether living or dead. Damaging living trees is considered to be damaging federal property (CFR 261.9), a citable offense. Burning of trash, building materials, and food scrapes is strictly prohibited.

Food and Washing: Campers may not prepare food, clean fish or wash dishes at bathhouses, hydrants, or the Davidson River. All cleaning, washing and food preparation should take place at the campsite.

Generators: Campers wishing to use generators may do so between the hours of 8am and 8pm. Generator use is limited to four hours.

Failure to comply with the Campground rules may result in eviction.
